TRINITY XIV

The Gospel Reading today jumps past the parable of the king's marriage feast, where his intimate friends all offer excuses not to attend - a narrative of rejection - and so the king demands that the poor, the crippled, the blind and the lame be invited, along with those from the 'highways and hedges'.

Jesus tells the crowd, and also us, in the starkest terms of the demands made of those who will follow him.

It can be easy to use entanglements with people and things as an excuse for rejecting Jesus and the Kingdom message.

Bearing our own cross and following Jesus is an invitation for the long haul - but we are invited to bear it with joy in our hearts and a spring in our step.
